Charlotte City Councilman Edwin Peacock III Files Tomorrow For At-Large Seat
The incumbent Republican will launch re-election campaign at 10:15 am

CHARLOTTE, NC – Charlotte City Councilman Edwin Peacock III will seek re-election in November for an at-large City Council seat by filing tomorrow at 10:15 am at the Board of Elections. Peacock is completing his first term.

"It is an honor to serve the citizens of Charlotte, and it would be a privilege to continue to serve them in the capacity of city councilman," said Peacock.
